
BLESSED ARE YOU!

Gospel: Matthew 5:1-12

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells the disciples and crowds 'WHO ARE THE BLESSED ONES'.

This teaching of Jesus is called 'THE BEATITUDES' meaning 'BLESSED'. Through the beatitudes Jesus reveals about the great blessings from heaven and who will get it. It explains the way of living as truly desired by God through each of us.
