

Gospel: Matthew 2:1-12

In the gospel today, we see the Magi from the east arriving in Jerusalem seeking the new-born king. Using their knowledge and wisdom and with all that they had, they recognized the Star rising during the time of the birth of Messiah and followed the star to reach Jesus to do him homage. On their way, they were called by King Herod, the king of Jerusalem, who was very much troubled regarding the birth of the new-born king.

First, Herod called all the chief Priests and the scribes of the people to inquire about Christs birth. They confirmed it to him through what was written by the prophet Micah. Then he called the Magi secretly to make sure regarding the time of the appearance of the star and sent them to Bethlehem. He said "Go and search diligently for the child. 


## Board Game.
