EASTER GARDEN

You will need:

- 1 tray
- 1 small empty plant pot
- Soil or sand
- 3 or 4 small flowering plant pots
- Small stones or pebbles
- 1 big stone to keep at the entrance
- 6 sticks (to make into 3 crosses)
- String or rubber bands
- You may also need an adult to help



- 1. Take the tray and place your plant pot on its side to make the tomb.
- 2. Cover half the tray (including over the side of the flowerpot) with soil or sand to make a hillside.
- 3. Place the big stone in front of the plant pot as if it appears half-opened. Place small stones or pebbles to form a path leading to the tomb.
- 4. Place the small flowering plant pots on either side of the tray.
- 5. With the sticks make three crosses by securing them with string or rubber bands: one cross bigger than the other two. Push them into the soil or sand at the top of the "hill". The bigger one at the centre to represent the cross which Jesus was crucified on.
