LIGHT THE CANDLE OF JOY; BY DRAWING A FLAME ON IT

Gospel: Matthew 11:2-11

In today's Gospel we see that, John Baptist is in prison. While in prison, he was filled in doubt about whether Jesus is the real messiah-the one who is to come? To clear his doubts, John send his followers to Jesus and asked him are you the one we were waiting for to come? or should we wait for another?


Jesus replied to the followers to go and tell what you hear and see and 'blessed is the one who does not reject him because of what he does.'


They saw: 'the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have good news brought to them'.

When they went off, Jesus started praising John the Baptist telling the crowds that he is more than a prophet and he is the messenger who prepares the way for Jesus. Jesus also told that 'among those born of women no one has arisen greater than John the Baptist; yet the least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he'

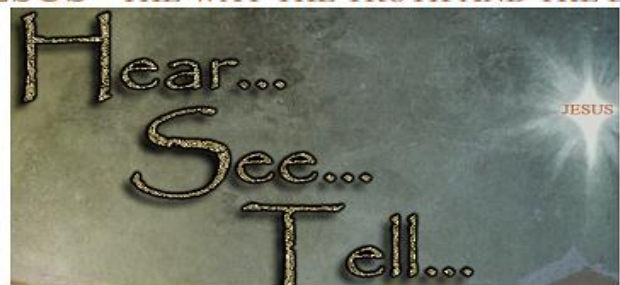

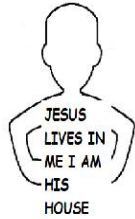

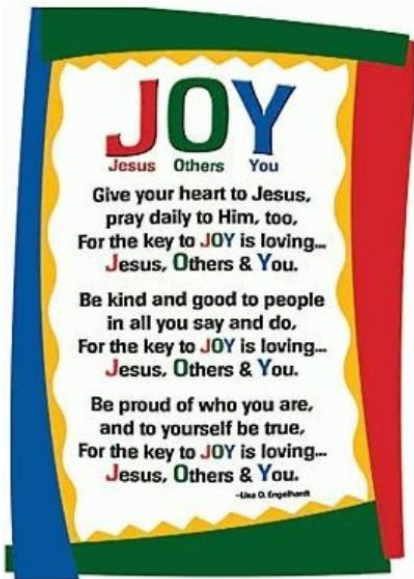
