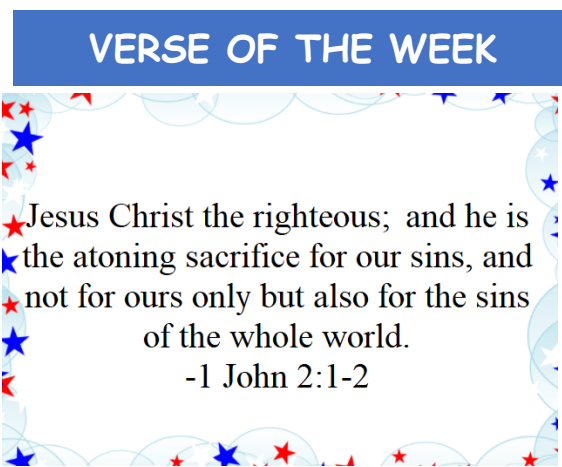
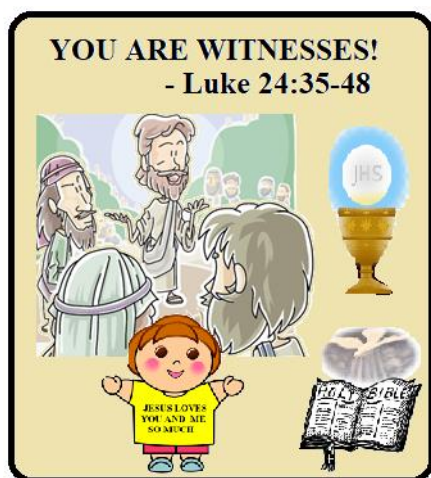


“You are Witnesses!”

Gospel: Luke 24:35-48

In the Gospel today, we see Jesus appearing to the disciples again. He gave them Peace . But they failed to realize that it was Jesus and got scared thinking that He was a ghost. Jesus showed his hands and feet. He asked them to touch and see. He even ate food in front of them to make them believe that He is Living. Because of joy and excitement, they were dumbfounded and failed to believe. Jesus then opened their mind to understand the scriptures. He reminded them that everything told about him in the law of Moses , the book of Prophets and Psalms ,that Christ must suffer , die, and rise again on the third day are being fulfilled and. After strengthening their faith, He commissioned them to be the Witnesses of all these and to preach repentance for forgiveness, to all nations starting from Jerusalem.

How are we experiencing the presence of the living lord Jesus amidst us now?

Jesus is coming to us living every day in the Holy Eucharist. Are we able to believe that Living Jesus is truly present in the Holy Eucharist and that we are receiving Him living in the Body and Blood?

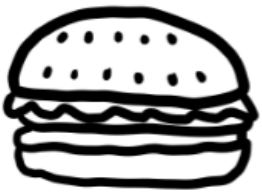

Circle everything that reveals the living presence of Jesus to us.

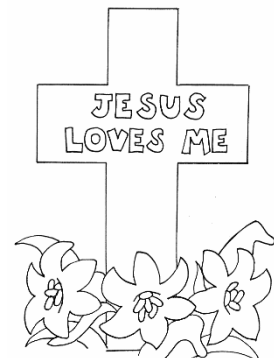
