
"Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?" Children's Liturgy Activity June 20th, 2021

Gospel: Mark 4:35-41



The wind ceased and the sea was calm. Jesus then asked to the disciples "Why are you afraid? Have you still no faith?". The disciples seeing all these stood in awe saying to each other ""Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?"

Jesus was seen sleeping peacefully amidst the raging sea and storm. He was able to do so because, he was confident and trusted in the providence of father in heaven.



Boat craft

<u>Materials Required:</u> Paper plate, scissors, colour, 2 Lolly sticks, Glue, Sticky tapes, Paper

Method: 1. Cut the paper plate into half. This is half is the boat. Colour it.

2. Cut out the triangle shape with the verses and colour it.

3. Stick the triangle shape to one end of the lolly stick 1.

4. Stick the other end of lolly stick 1 to the back of the paper plate to form the mast of the sailboat.

5. Take lolly stick 2 and glue to the down of the boat as to hold it.

6. Take a paper and make a slit in the middle of it. Draw waves in the paper

7. Insert the lolly stick 2 through the slit of the paper to move the boat in the waves.
