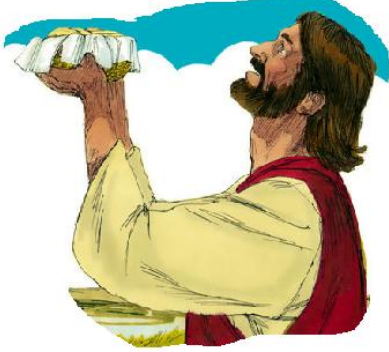

## VERSES OF THE WEEK

Gospel: Matthew 14:13-21

In today's gospel, we see Jesus multiplying the little that was offered by the disciples to feed around 5000 people.

Jesus, through the Gospel today shows how we can share even the little that we have, to satisfy many.

Jesus was compassionate on a large crowd of about 5000 people who gathered to listen to him. As the time was getting late, Jesus's disciples suggested to send them to buy food. But Jesus replied "They do not need to go away. You give them something to eat". There were only five loaves and two fishes with them, which the disciples' thought was too little to feed the crowd.

Jesus asked them to bring to him what they had. After asking the people to sit down, Jesus took the five loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven gave thanks and broke the loaves and gave it to the disciples to distribute to the crowd. They all ate to the full and were satisfied. The left-over were filled 12 baskets full.

WHAT DOES JESUS TEACH US THROUGH THIS INCIDENT?

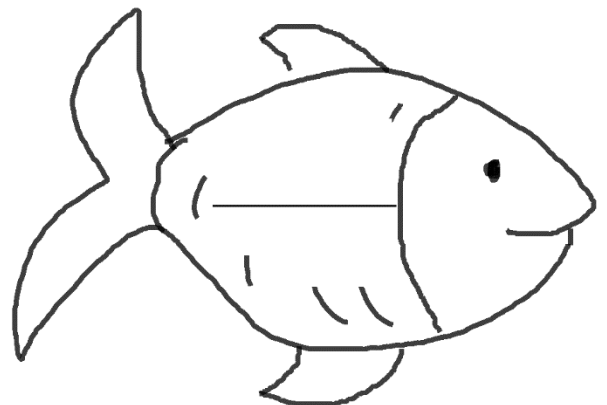
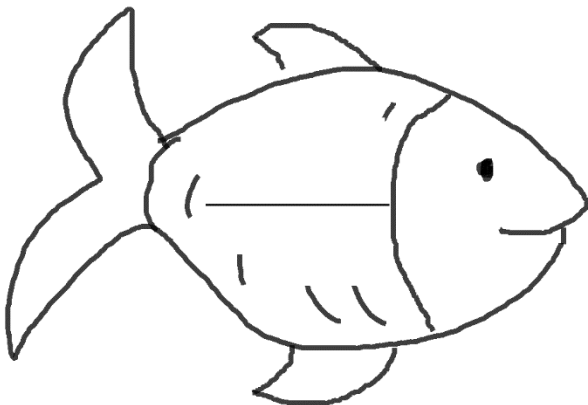
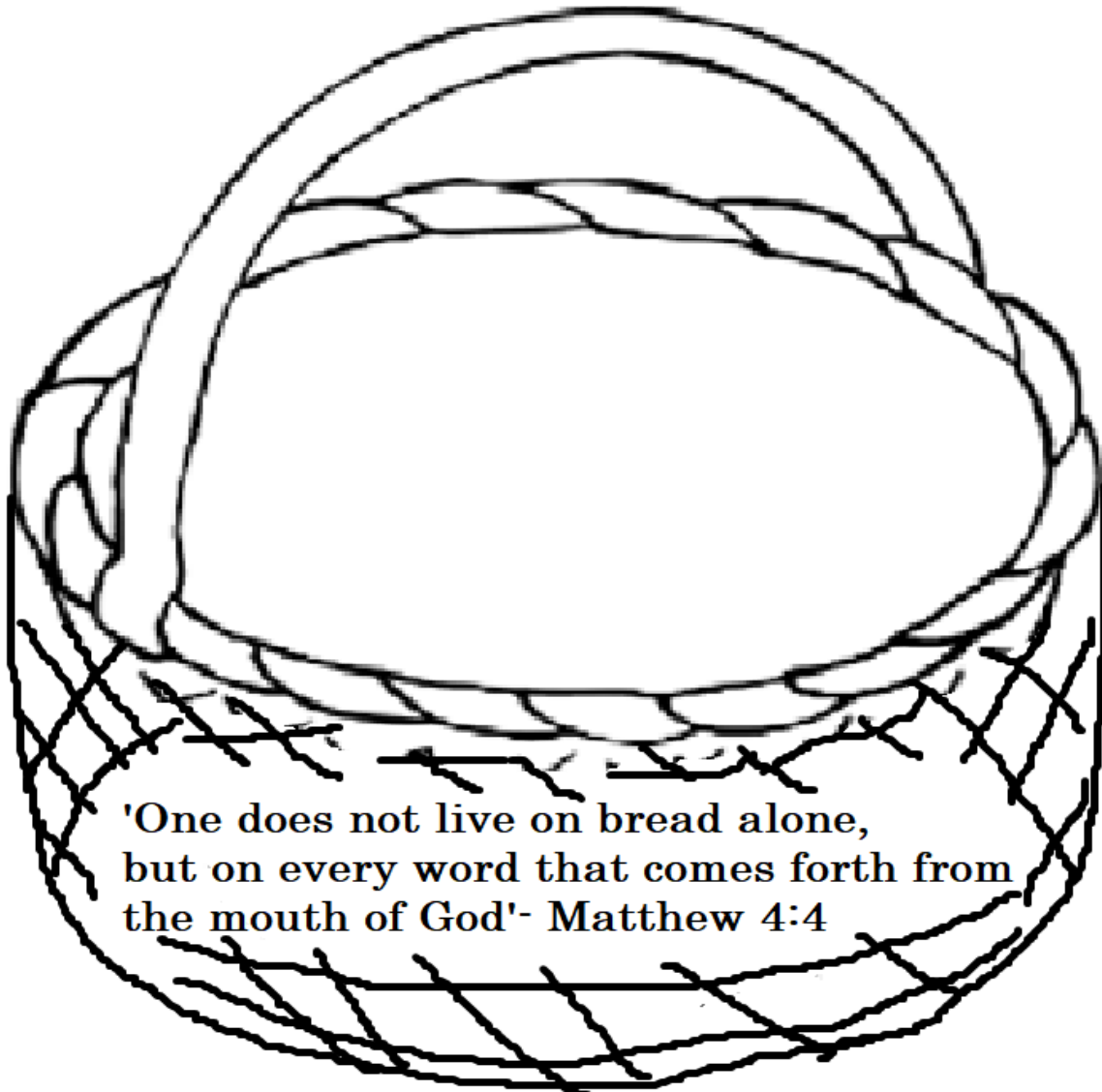

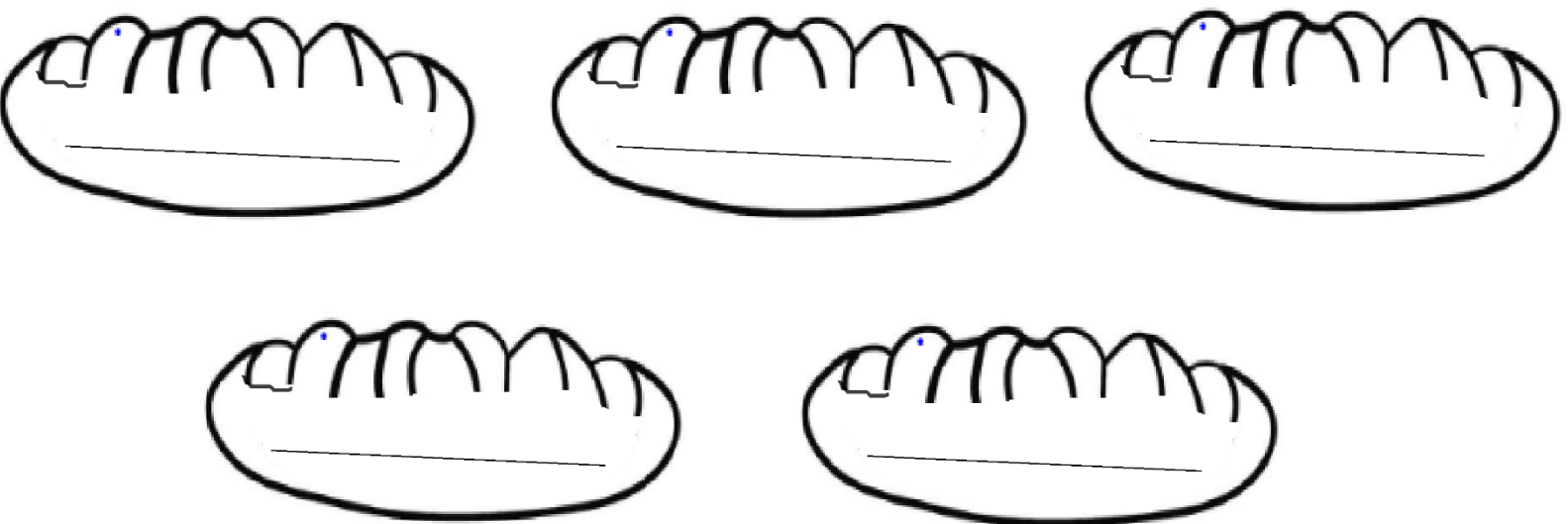
So, let us in true heart, offer all that we have unto Jesus and pray to him to use it for the eternal purpose.

Let us reflect, IS THERE ANYTHING THAT WE ARE HESITATING TO OFFER TO JESUS?

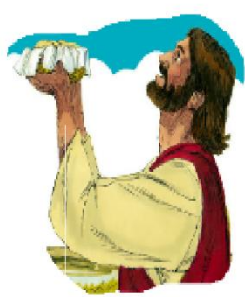
LET US PRAY FOR GOD'S GRACE TO OFFER IT TO JESUS COMPLETELY.

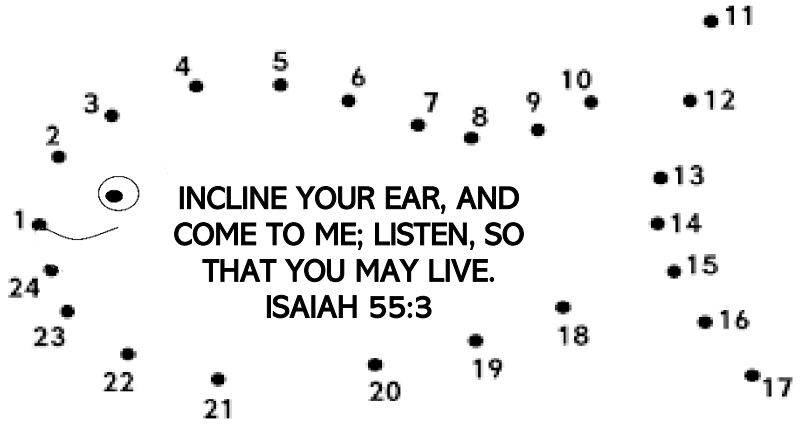


CAN YOU NUMBER THE STORY IN THE CORRECT ORDER?



JOIN THE DOTS

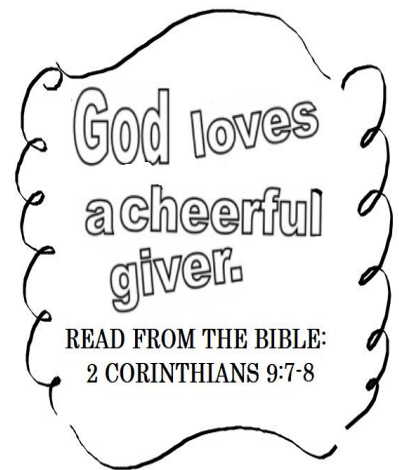
