LIGHT THE CANDLE OF **PEACE**; BY DRAWING A FLAME ON IT Gospel: Matthew 3:1-12

In today's gospel we see John the Baptist preaching in the desert of Judea. He preached "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!" Prophet Isaiah had spoken about him when he said: 'A voice of one crying out in the desert, Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths.'

John wore clothing made of camel's hair, had a leather belt around his waist. His food was locusts and wild honey.

All people around Jerusalem, Judea and Jordan went to Him and got baptized by him in the Jordan River as they said sorry for their sins.

When he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming to be baptized, he said to them, Produce good fruit as evidence of your repentance. Do not be proud of yourselves or of your forefathers. Every one that does not bear good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire.

I am baptizing you with water, for repentance, but the one who is coming after me is mightier than I. I am not worthy to carry his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. He will gather the fruitful ones separating from the unfruitful ones.

Can we dress up John the Baptist? Do you remember his outfits and food?


