Gospel: Matthew 14:22-33

In today's gospel, we see Jesus is going alone to pray to His Father after sending His disciples in a boat.

As the disciples were sailing, the boat was caught in a great storm. They were frightened. Suddenly, they saw someone approaching them by walking on the sea. They thought it was a ghost and cried out. But the person replied, 'do not be afraid, it is I, Jesus!'

Peter was in a bit of doubt. He asked Jesus that, if it was He, let him come to Jesus by walking on the water. Jesus asked him to come. Peter took courage and looking at Jesus began to walk on the water. But as soon as he lost his focus on Jesus to the water and storm, he began to sink.

Peter cried out to save him. Jesus replied, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?". As Jesus entered the boat, the wind stopped. Those in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."

WHAT DOES JESUS TEACH US THROUGH THE GOSPEL?

Jesus asks us to trust in Him and not to be afraid - He is always with us. At times when we feel alone or left out, we question where God is. Jesus tells us to focus on Him and not on the world.

Let's think, WHOM DO WE TRUST THE MOST? WHAT MADE US TRUST THEM?

Knowing more about Jesus increases our faith.


HOW CAN WE KNOW HIM MORE?

NEVER LOSE FOCUS ON JESUS






FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS TO MAKE A PAPER BOAT.
