"Allow it now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness."-Matthew 3:15 Gospel: Matthew 3:13-17


In today's Gospel we hear the story of the baptism of our lord Jesus. Baptism of Jesus is the occasion on which he is equipped for his ministry by the holy Spirit and proclaimed to be the Son of God.

John the Baptist was baptizing in the river Jordan. Jesus too came to be baptized by John. When John saw Jesus coming to him to be baptized, he was reluctant to baptize Jesus who is greater than him and who is not a sinner. But Jesus assures him that "Allow it now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness." To fulfill Lords plan of human salvation, John has to obey Jesus and Jesus had to humble himself and say yes for Gods plans. Then he allowed him.


