"Rejoin, Share and Rest with Jesus" Children's Liturgy Activity July 18th, 2021





The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want. Psalms 23:1

Gospel: Mark 6:30-34

In the gospel today, we see the disciples re-joining with Jesus after their mission. They shared everything happened during their mission journey with Jesus. Jesus asks his disciples that they must come to a lonely place and rest for a while as it had been very busy for them and had no time even to have food.

As they resided to a lonely place to rest, Jesus saw large crowds following them. He stepped ashore and looked the crowd with pity. Jesus felt them like 'sheep without a shepherd'. He set himself to teach them.

We come across a very caring and compassionate Jesus in today's gospel. At first, we understand about the great love and care that Jesus has for his disciples who returned from the busy mission. He asks them to come with him to lonely place so that they can spent time together by themselves. Jesus also asks them to take rest for a while. We find the disciples who was on the mission returns to Jesus and is sharing everything with Jesus. Jesus wishes the same from each of us. After a busy day, we must REJOIN with him, sit with him and SHARE everything happened that day.

Do we make time every day to spend with Jesus?



Despite being rest time, Jesus feels pity for the people who followed them. He felt the real need in the people to be fed and guided by Him. Jesus points out that they were so desperate like 'sheep without a shepherd'. Sheep without shepherd are always left unsatisfied without being led to proper green pastures and is in danger of being attacked or scattered. Jesus did not turn them down. He did not put the task to the tired disciples. Jesus himself set to serve the people. At times when we are too tired, do we have the same attitude as Jesus to those who approach us in need? Do we help someone who is tired as Jesus helped, by setting ourselves for doing the tasks?

Jesus ,our compassionate Shepherd, gave his life to save us and provides us with heavenly treasures. He is our provider ,He is our shepherd who leads us to green pastures of life ,He is the source of our peace ,let us trust in him and cling to him. All the busy chores of the day might exhaust us. No matter how busy we are or how desperate we are, let us rejoin Jesus, sit with him, share with Jesus, and find rest in Jesus. As we rest in Jesus, we will be filled in Jesus' peace We will fill in wisdom. We can hear the voice of Our shepherd and we are provided with the right. Let us help others who are tired and never turn them away but offer them and lead them to Jesus.

At the end of each day before going to bed, let us talk to Jesus and rest in Him.


