
"FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING"

Children's Liturgy Activity November 21st, 2021





Gospel: John 18:33-37

In today's gospel, we see Jesus is being brought to Pilate, the Roman governor, to pass His execution. Pilate asks him 'Are you the King of Jews?' Jesus says to him that his kingdom is not a kingdom of this world. If it was a worldly kingdom, Jesus' army would have fought to prevent Jesus being surrendered to the Jews. But Jesus reveals that his kingdom is not of this kind.' Pilate confirms whether Jesus is a king. Jesus said 'yes'. Jesus also revealed that, He is born to this world to bear witness to the truth; and all who are on the side of truth listen to His voice.'

Are you a king?, Pilate asked Jesus. Pilate was the Roman governor. The Jews regarded Herod as their king. The roman emperor was Caesar. No other leaders were accepted to Jews. The Jews handed over Jesus to Pilate because Jesus was revealing him as King of Jews. The Jews were expecting a Messiah, but they had a picture of a warrior king who will fight with romans and free them. They didn't expect someone like Jesus.

What do you think a king should be like? Kings have power. kings have wealth, kings ruled and bossed over people. Kings uses armies to fight and conquer places on Earth. All the above characters of king point towards earthly kingdoms. We measure kingship based on world, human gains and efforts. Did Jesus do any of these? How is Jesus a King?

Jesus says: 'Mine is not a kingdom of this world'. What is Jesus talking about? Where is his kingdom? and what kind of king is he? The kingdom Jesus speaks of kingdom of Heaven. Jesus the king emptied himself for the world and saved all from bonds of sin and evil by crushing the head of satan. He resurrected and is seated at right hand of father in heaven. His name is above all names for salvation of the whole world. Jesus loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood and made us a kingdom, priests to his God and Father. -Revelation 1:5






