
LOVE FULFILLS THE LAW

VERSES OF THE WEEK

'You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.
You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' -Matthew 22:37-39

Gospel: Matthew 22:34-40

In today's gospel we see a scholar of the laws testing Jesus by asking a question,' which commandment in the law is the greatest?' Jesus answers to him in the wisdom of God that "the greatest and the first commandment is 'You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' And the second is: You shall love your neighbour as yourself.' Jesus makes it clear that 'the whole law and the prophets depend on these two commandments.'

Laws has been given to help and guide people to live in harmony and peace by taking care of each other and the nature. All the laws reflect our actions based on the love that we should have for our fellow beings. If there is love, no laws will be violated. Let us check on our LOVE, is it kind? Loving? patient? forgiving? ...or is it selfish? boasting? Our love must be pure. It must be sacrificing, forgiving love.

HOW CAN WE FILL IN THIS LOVE?

By knowing JESUS, whom God gave us out of His love towards us and what HE is doing for us out of love. His holy spirit fills us with His love and helps us 'to love our god with all our mind heart and soul'.

WE HAVE TO FILL IN THE LOVE OF GOD TO LOVE OUR NEGHBOURS AND TO SEE JESUS LIVING IN THEM.

As we fill in God's love, we must flow this love to our fellow beings. By loving our neighbours, we love God himself. The more we give, the more we receive. 


