Gospel: Matthew 21:28-32: 'CHANGE YOUR MIND AND BELIEVE IN JESUS'

In today's Gospel, we see Jesus talking to the elders and chief Priests with a parable about a man who had two sons. He tells his first son 'Son, go out and work in the vineyard today.' The son said 'I will not' but later changes his mind and goes to work. The man said the same to his second son. Even though he agreed to go, he did not go. Jesus then asked them, 'out of the two sons, who did the Father's will? They replied, 'the first one'.

Jesus said to them that the sinners will enter the kingdom of God before them. Because even though they were disobedient at first, when they came to know the way of righteousness through John the Baptist, changed their minds and believed in him. But you have not believed yet or is ready to change your mind.

Through this gospel, Jesus makes us understand that, it is not just by hearing the will of the father, but it is by being ready to change ourselves according to His will, that makes us enter the Kingdom of God.

ARE WE SEEKING GODS WILL IN ALL WE DO?


IF SO, ARE WE READY TO CHANGE ACCORDING TO GODS WILL?

IF NOT, LET US DO IT FROM NOW ON.



Can you spot which son reached first?



Can you find persons from the Bible who OBEYED what the Lord SAID?


