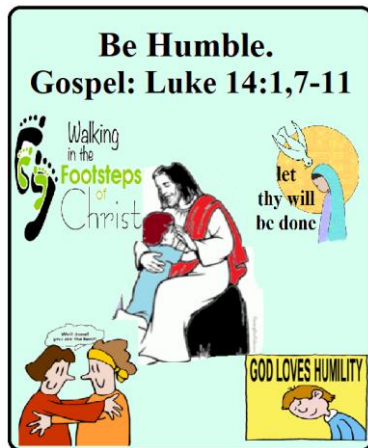


“Be Humble”

That others may be chosen and I set aside,

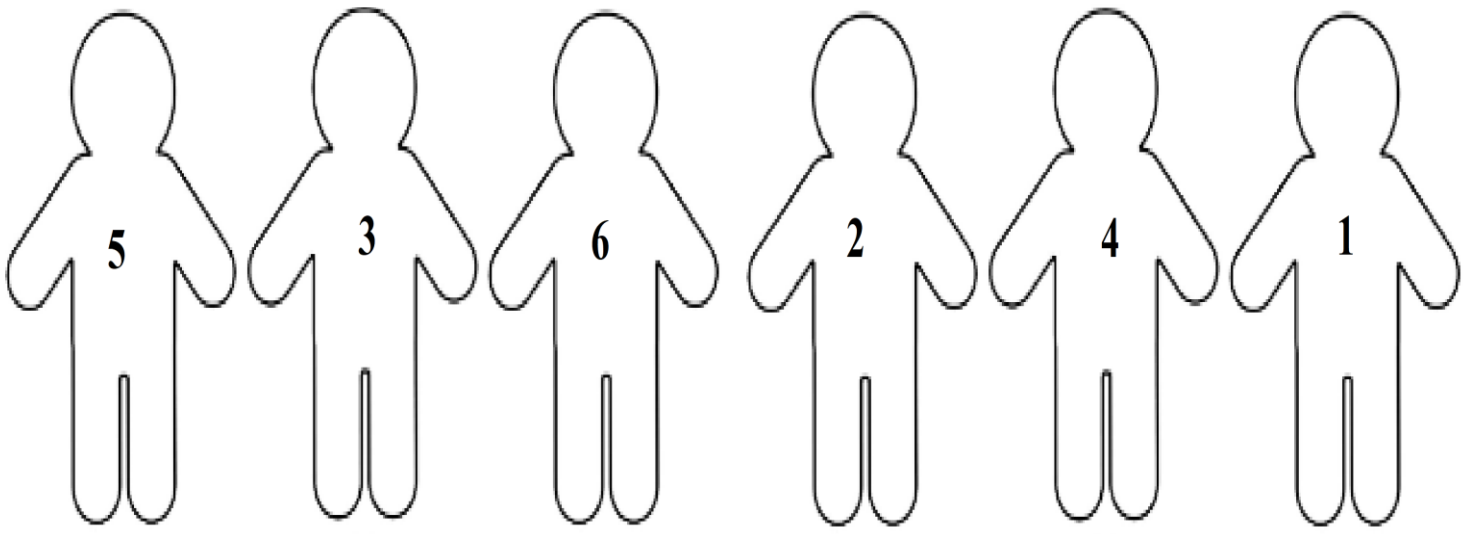
That others may be praised and I unnoticed,
