"THE MOST HOLY TRINITY"

'I am with you always to the end of time.' Children's liturgy activity May 30th, 2021





Gospel: Matthew 28:16-20

In the gospel today, we see Jesus meeting with his disciples as he had previously arranged. The disciples fell before him and adoring him. Jesus is speaking to his disciples about their mission by giving them great assurance.

What did Jesus speak about the mission of the disciples?

- 1.Go, therefore, make disciples of all the nations
- 2.Baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit
- 3. Teach them to observe all the commands I gave you.

What is the authority and the assurance that Jesus gives to His disciples to carry on with His mission? Jesus says to them that 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me', go therefore and make disciples. The authority that the disciples are given to carry on the mission is the authority of Jesus. By Jesus passion, death and resurrection from the dead, Father in heaven gave him all authority on earth and heaven. God put this power to work in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places, far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the age to come. (Ephesians 1:20-21)

What assurance or help does Jesus promise his disciples for the mission?


Jesus promises, 'I am with you always; yes, to the end of time.' Jesus himself first accomplished the mission from His father, and he promises to be with them forever to instruct, guide and help in everything.



The father in heaven, his word incarnate flesh the Son and The Holy Spirit- the advocate from father sent through son. We are being made his disciples by the mission carried on in the authority of Jesus, by the apostles, through our Church, who instructs us and teaches us what Jesus has commanded. Let us realize that we are joined to the family of Holy Trinity of the Father, the Son and the Holy spirit and be responsible for Jesus' mission entrusted to us in our baptism. To live and teach what Jesus has commanded us that is reflected to us through Church. Let us make disciples to follow Jesus by reflecting his love and joining many in the family of Holy Trinity. Let us carry out our mission in the great assurance and promise of Jesus that He is with us to the end of the time.




Holy Trinity Craft

Materials needed: Flower petal template cut out, stem template cut out, colours, glue, scissors

Method: 1. Cut out the flower petal shapes. Colour it any colour you like

- 3. Now glue each petal overlapping on the circle shape so that the circle with the writing comes on top.
- 4. Glue the completed flower on top of the circle shape on the stem template.

 Your Holy Trinity flower is ready.


