"One does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes forth from the mouth of God."

- Matthew 4:4

Gospel: Matthew 4:1-11

In today's gospel, we see, that the holy Spirit is leading Jesus to the desert to be tempted by Satan. Jesus was fasting and praying for forty days and forty nights in the desert after which Satan appeared to tempt him. Jesus was tempted * by asking him to change stones to bread

*by asking Him to jump from top of the temple and thus to test Lord and validity of his promises

* by promising Authority Riches and wealth, if he worship satan

Temptation comes from Satan , he tries to get us to do wrong. The temptations are worldly attractions that Satan present to take us away from lords' purpose of our creation. But Jesus overcame each temptation with wisdom, **the word of god.** He stood strong in the Word of God in faith and said NO to the temptations. He gained strength by prayer and fasting.
