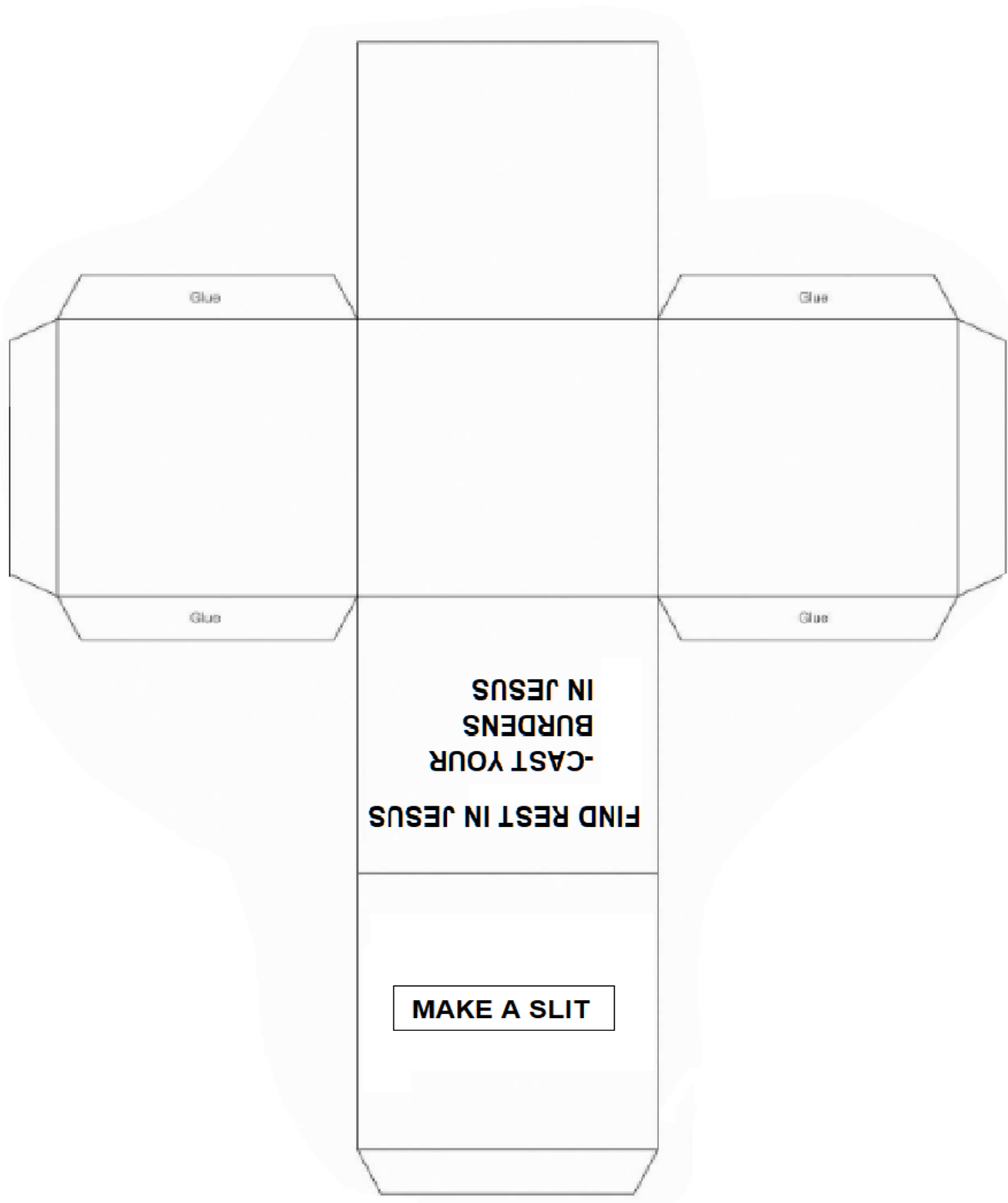

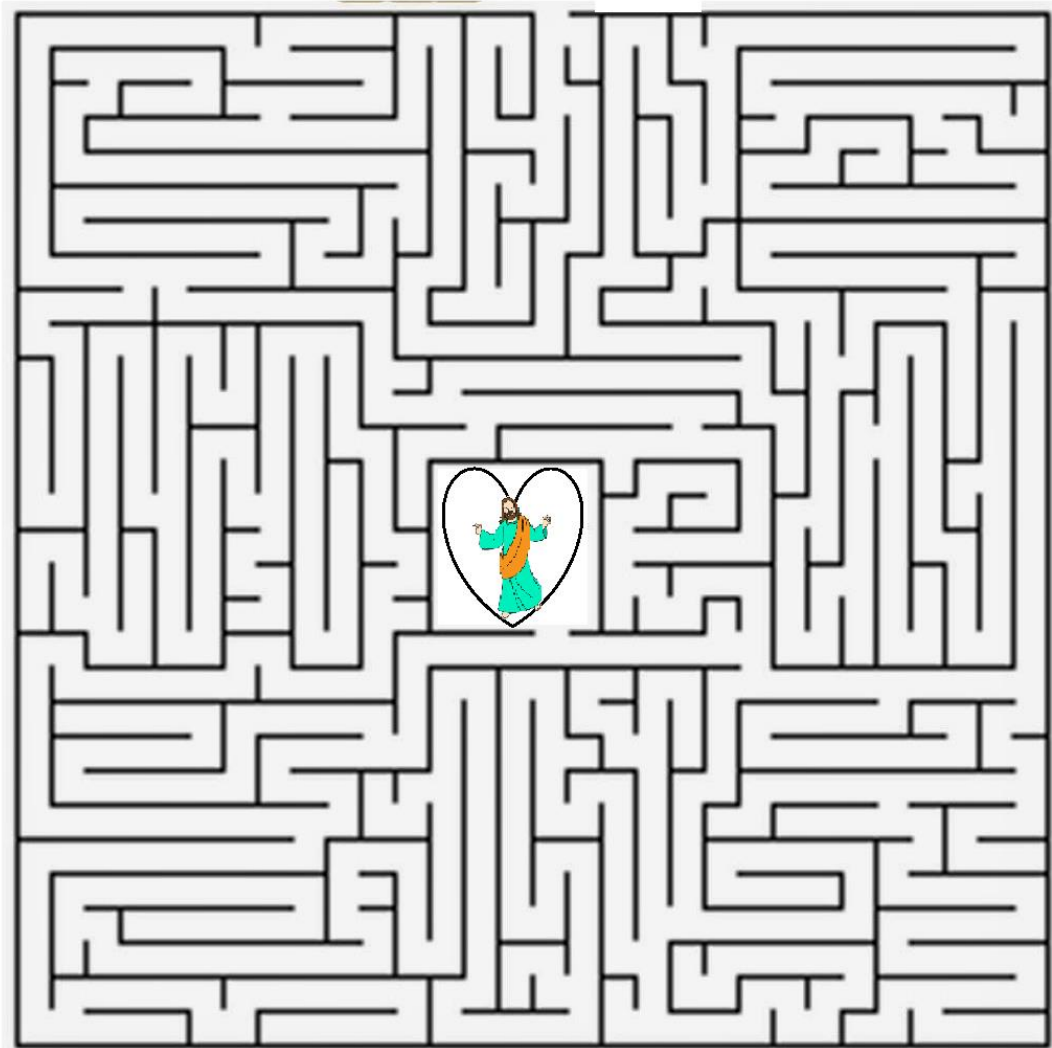
COME TO ME

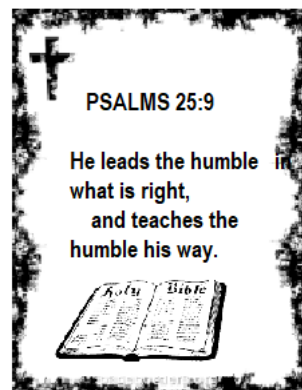
