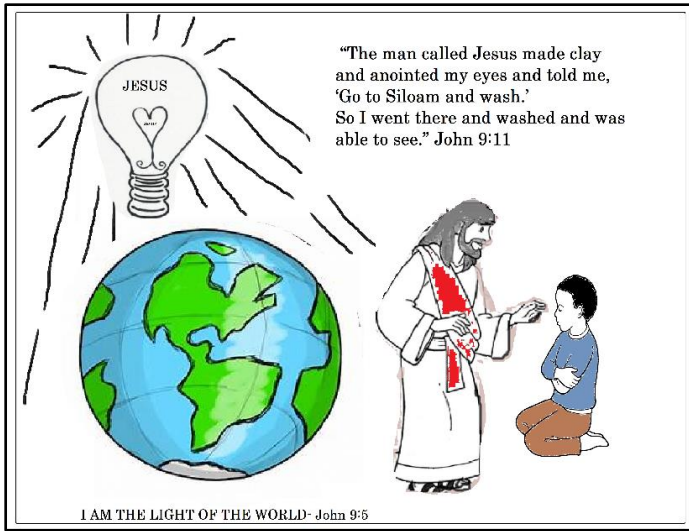

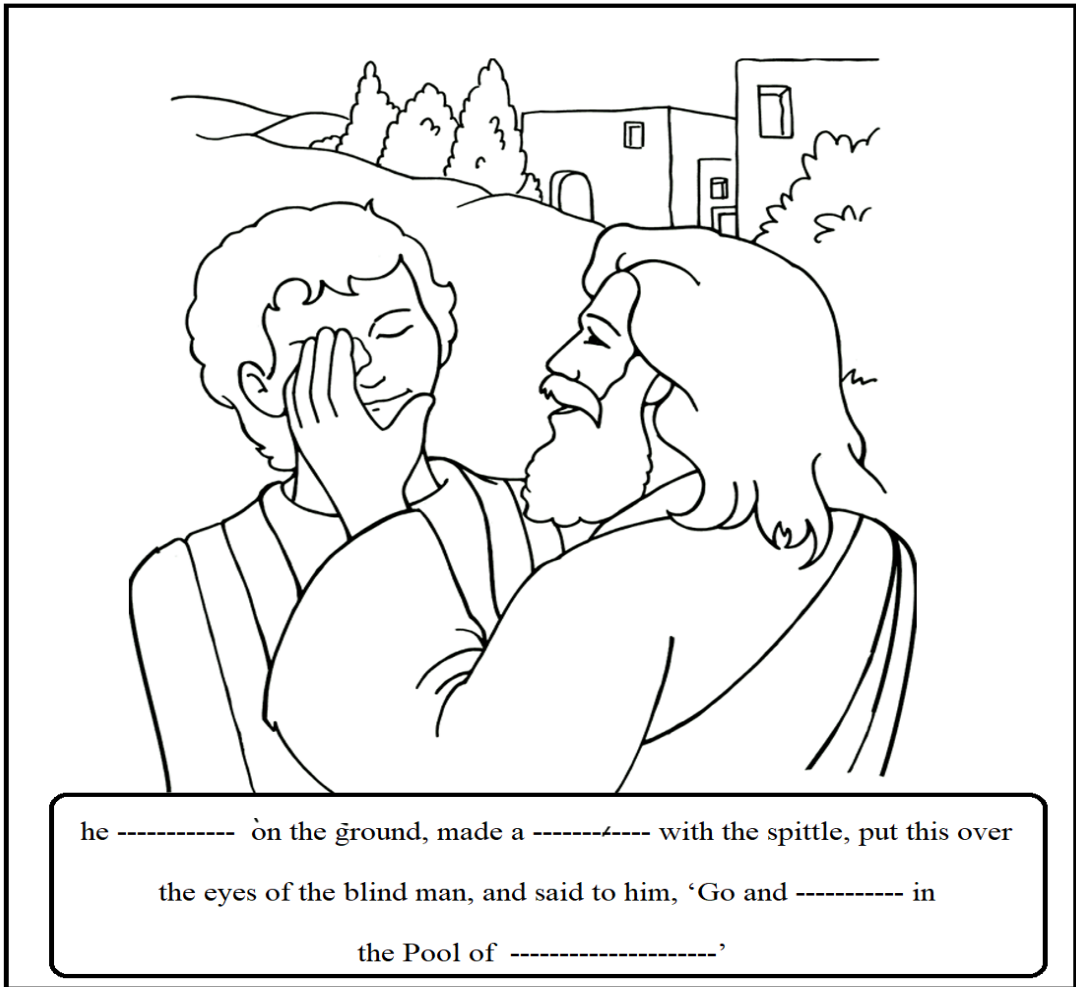

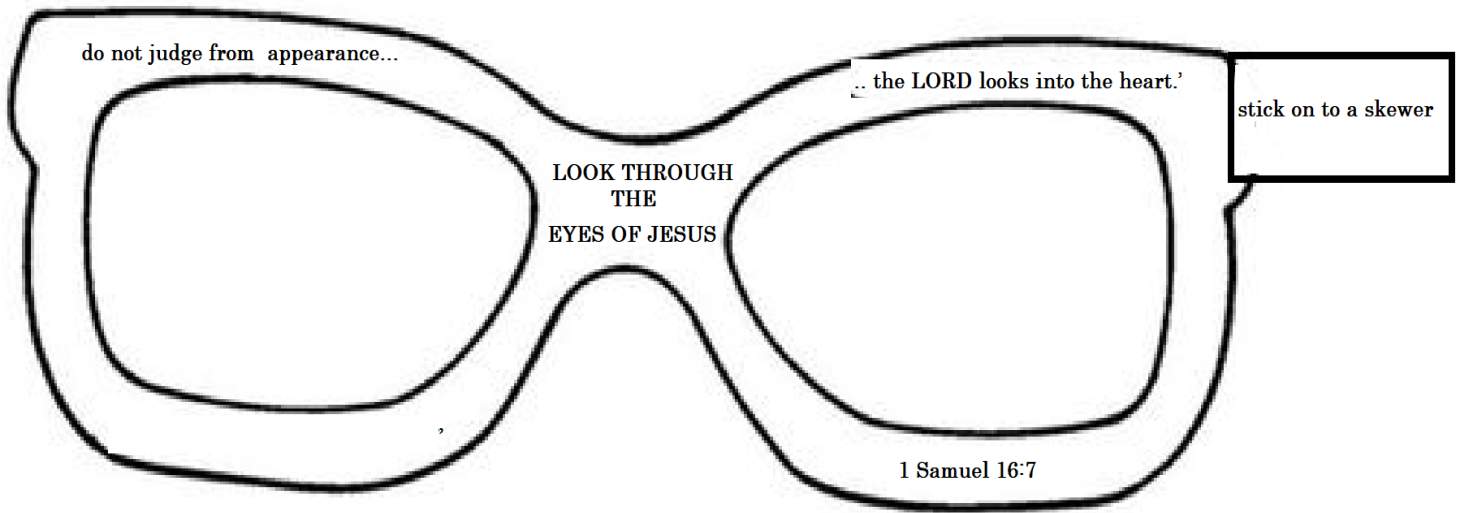

You were darkness once, but now you are light in the Lord; be like children of light - Ephesians 5:8

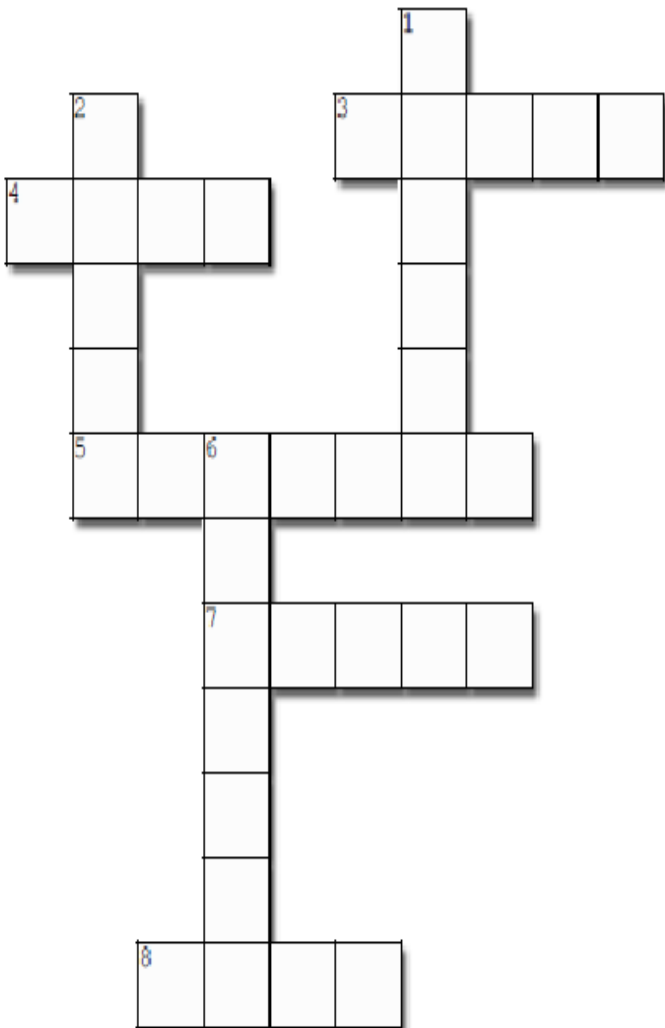

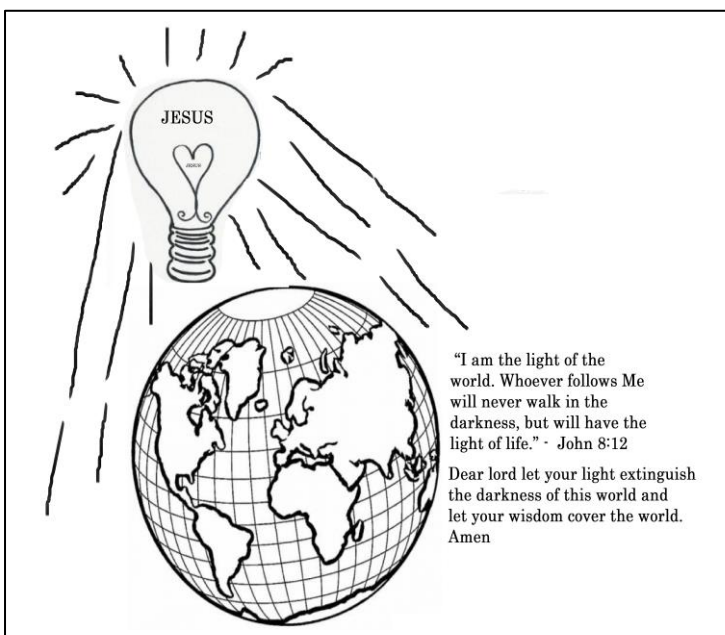
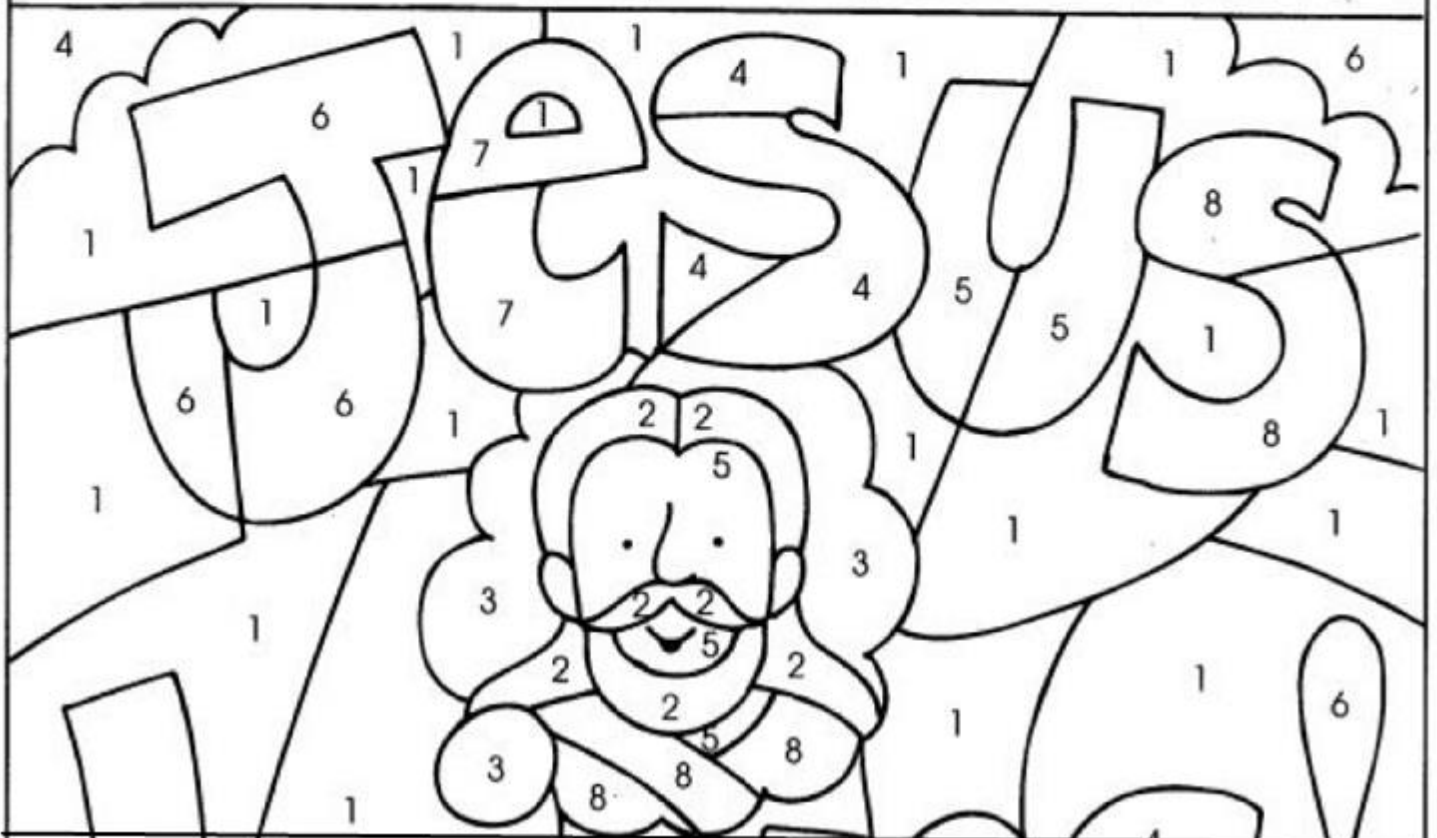
