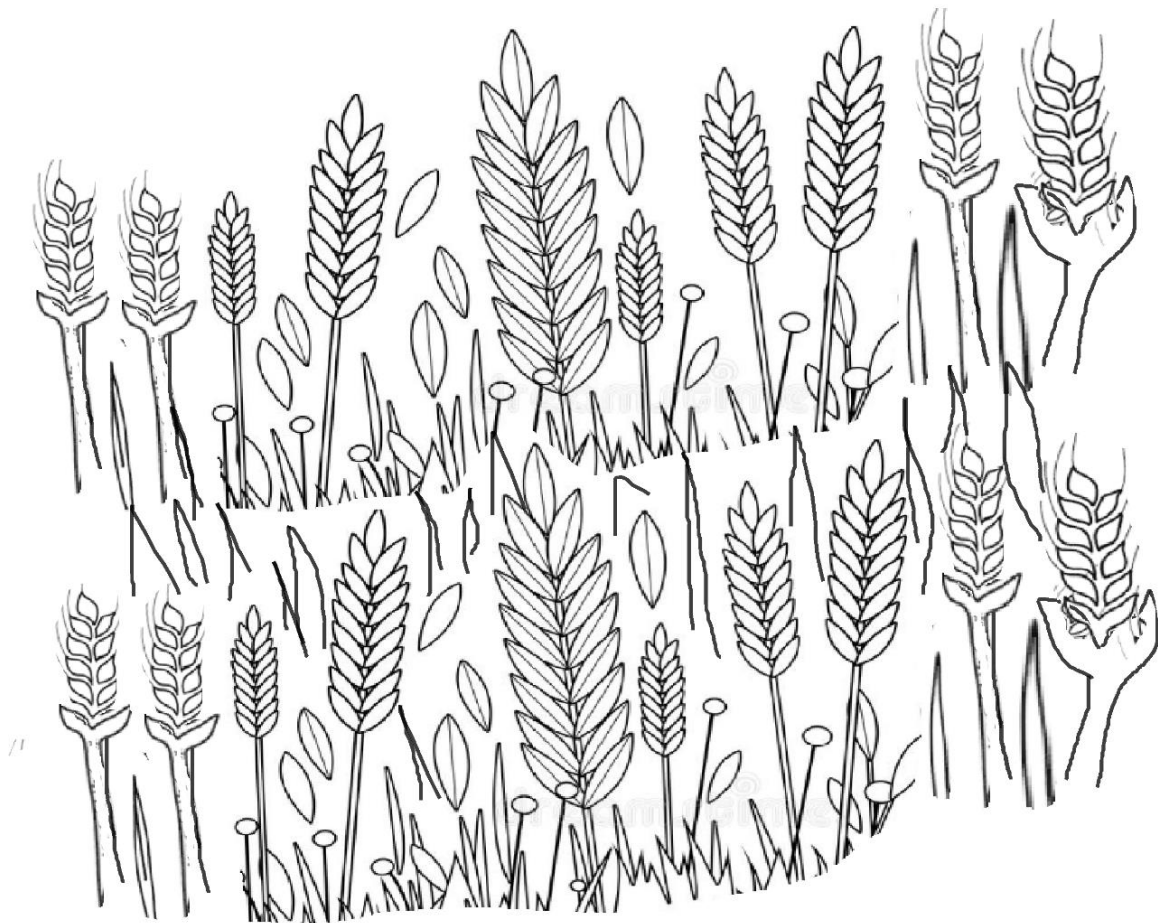


CAN YOU UNSCRAMBLE THE GIVEN VERSES?
