

**“Today this scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing.”**  
**Children’s Liturgy Activity January 23<sup>rd</sup> , 2022**



**Gospel: Luke 4:14-21**

In the gospel today, we see Jesus entering the synagogue in Nazareth and standing up to read. Jesus was given the scroll of prophet Isaiah. Jesus read out the scripture portion from the Book of Isaiah: The spirit of the Lord has been given to me, has anointed me. He has sent me to bring the good news to the poor, to proclaim liberty to captives and to the blind new sight, to set the downtrodden free, to proclaim the Lord’s year of favour. He gave back the scroll and sat down to reflect on it.

Are we reminded of anything? The Holy Mass. We have the bible readers. In the Holy Mass there are: reading Psalms, reading from Old Testament, a reading from the letters of Paul. We welcome the gospel. The Priest read the Gospel for us and explains it for us.

The word Jesus read was Isaiah's prophecy about Him. Isaiah is the prophet of the Old Testament. He was filled with God’s revelations. He prophesied about Jesus. To find out more, please read the Book of Isaiah from the Bible. The prophecy of Isaiah was fulfilled in Jesus. In Jesus’ baptism, the Holy Spirit descended upon Him like a dove and Father in heaven revealed Jesus to the people. Today in the synagogue, Jesus is again revealing himself to the people of Nazareth that Lord’s Spirit is upon him.

What was the purpose of giving Jesus Holy Spirit and Anointing him? To accomplish Father’s Eternal plan of Salvation. To bring the good news to poor, to proclaim liberty to captives, to give new sight to blind, to det the lowly free, to proclaim lord’s year of favour.

In Christ we were received into God’s family. Having washed away from sin by Holy Baptism, we are made partakers of His divine nature by the communion of the Holy Spirit. So, what is our mission in Christ? Our mission is to Follow Christ and to spread His light to the world. Christ- The Living Word fulfilled. Christ himself is the living word. He is the Power and Wisdom of God. (1 Corinthians 1:24). Each time we read or hear the living word, Christ is being revealed to us. Jesus is revealing truth and wisdom to all hearing the living word and His word gives light to them to follow the way of truth leading to eternal life.

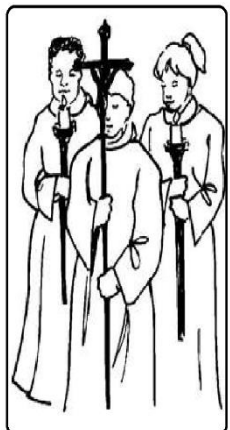
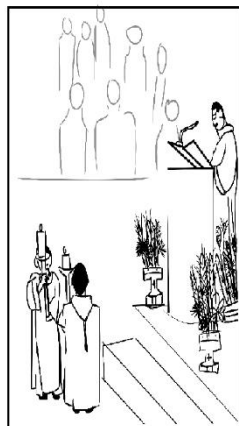

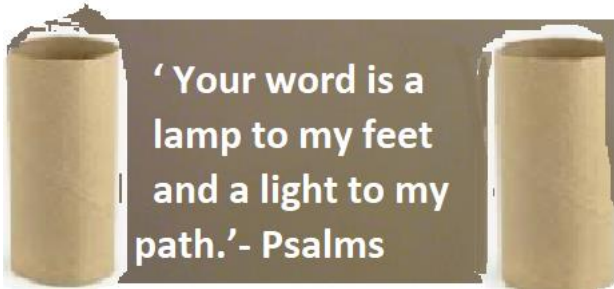
## Scroll craft

### Materials Required:

Paper, Tea Bag, Toilet tissue roll tubes, Scissors, Strings, Glue, Felt tips.

### Method:

1. Take the paper and damp it with a wet tea bag so that the paper is coloured brown.
2. Leave the paper to dry.
3. Once dry, take the paper and cut it in length of the tissue tubes.
4. Write the following verses on the prepared paper using felt tip:  
'Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.' - Psalms 119:105
5. Glue the toilet tissue tubes one each at the ends of the paper and leave it to dry.
6. Roll the tubes along with the paper from both ends to meet in the middle, just like a scroll. Decorate it.
7. Tie strings around the tubes and secure the scroll.
