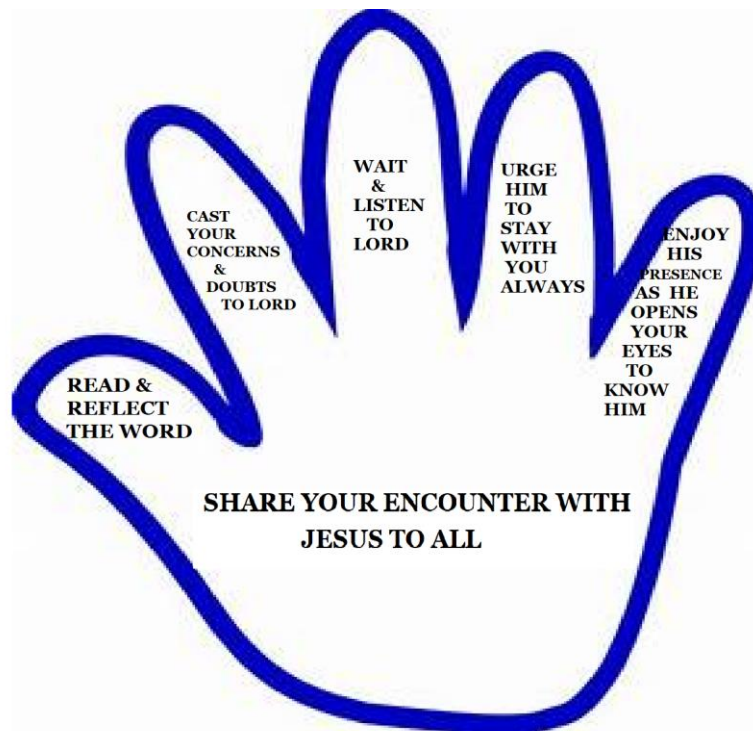

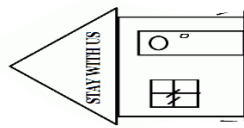
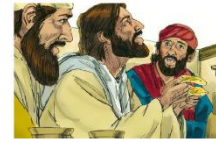
FIND FROM BIBLE:
