Suddenly a cloud covered them, and a voice came from the cloud: 'This is my Son, the Beloved. Listen to him.' They looked around but they saw no one with them anymore but only Jesus.

Even though they did not understand what 'rising from the dead' could mean, they obeyed faithfully what Jesus asked of them. Have you been to mountains? How do you feel the place? Mountains are places away from the distractions and chaos of this world. It is calm, peaceful, and serene over the mountains. Today in the Gospel, we see Jesus leading his three friends to the mountains. Why do you think He took them high up there? What does He reveal to them?

Jesus is inviting us to high mountains of prayer experiences. He wishes to have us alone with Him, away from worlds distractions. He desperately wishes to talk to us and reveal to us many things. In our prayer times, Jesus reveals to us to know Him more and more. He opens to us the heavenly truths and about the real state of eternity that we must reach. Are we following Jesus when He calls us to high places of prayer?

We might get excited like Peter and begin to devise our own plans, but as we see in today's Gospel, the voice from the cloudthe voice of Father in Heaven-directs us always to Listen to Jesus, His beloved son and not to devise our own plans. Listen more to Jesus. Are we listening to Jesus or instructing?

Sometimes we might not understand clearly what Jesus is revealing but let us put our faith in him and obey just like his friends. In this time of Lent, let us pray for God's grace to spend more time with Jesus, who is waiting for us to talk with us and reveal many things. Let us always Listen to Him and do as He say. This is the Fathers wish.






Cut the paper plate as shown in the picture. Glue its both ends as shown. Colour it green/brown for the mountain.


Cut out the templates of the apostles and transfigured Jesus. Fold along the given lines and colour it and Glue it as shown.
