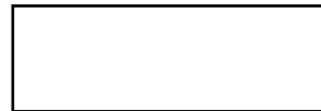
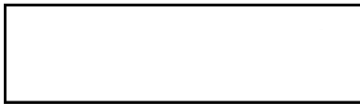
Live on Earth to be Rewarded in Heaven

-1 Timothy 6:11

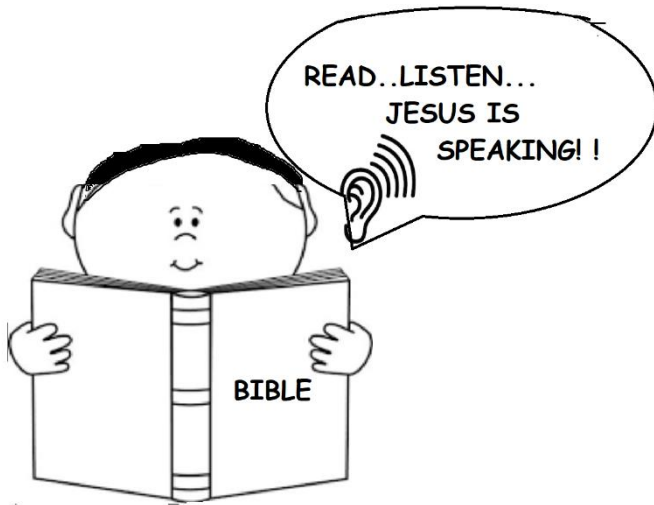
Have a read on the Parable from Luke 16:19-31,
