

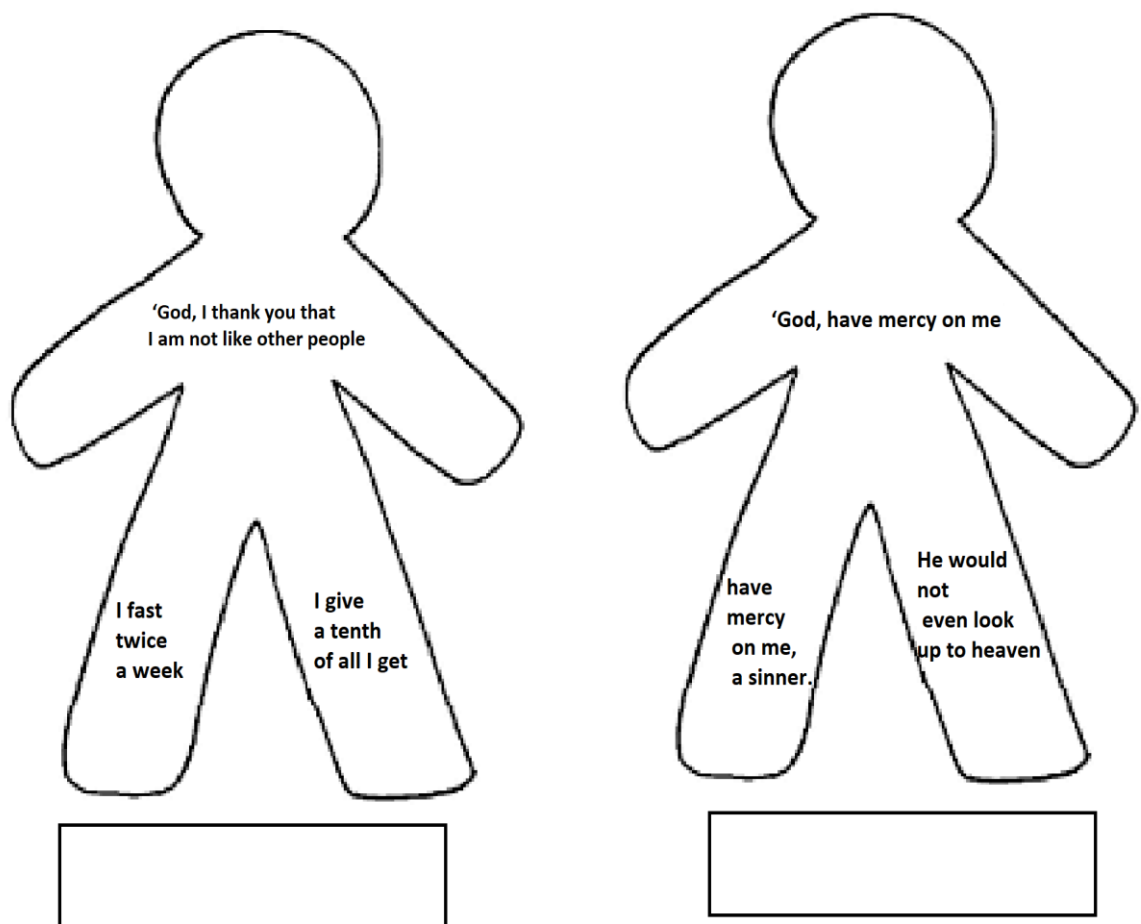
Children's Liturgy Activity October 27th, 2019

"everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted." (Luke 18:14)

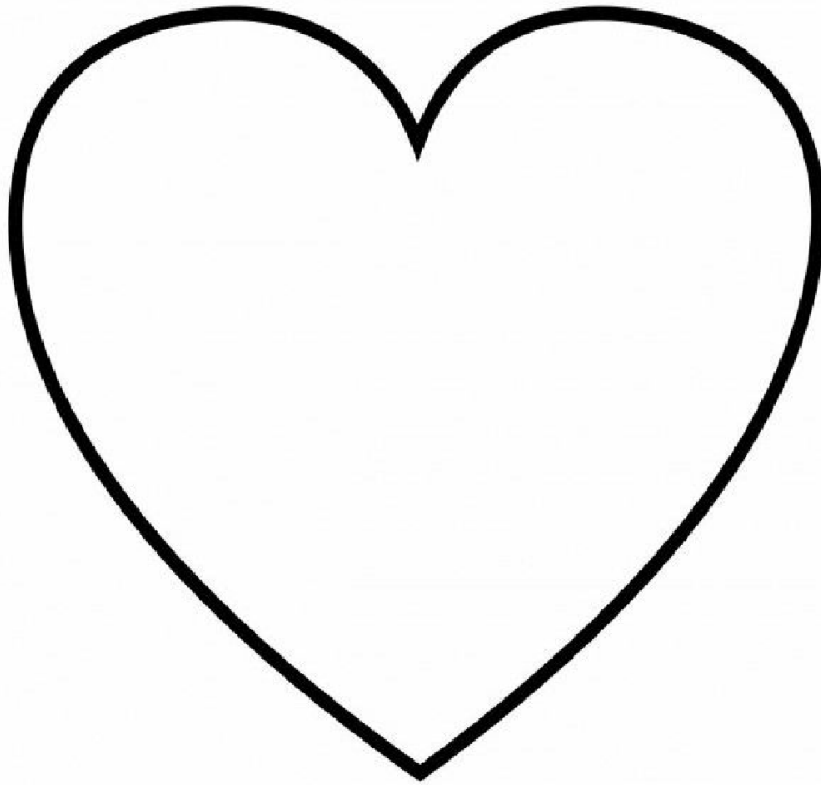
Who am I? Can you identify the pharisee and the tax collector from the below persons? Draw them a face.

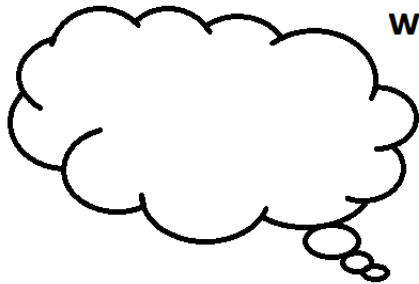
