This Christmas, don't forget to thank God for the gift of Jesus, His Son.

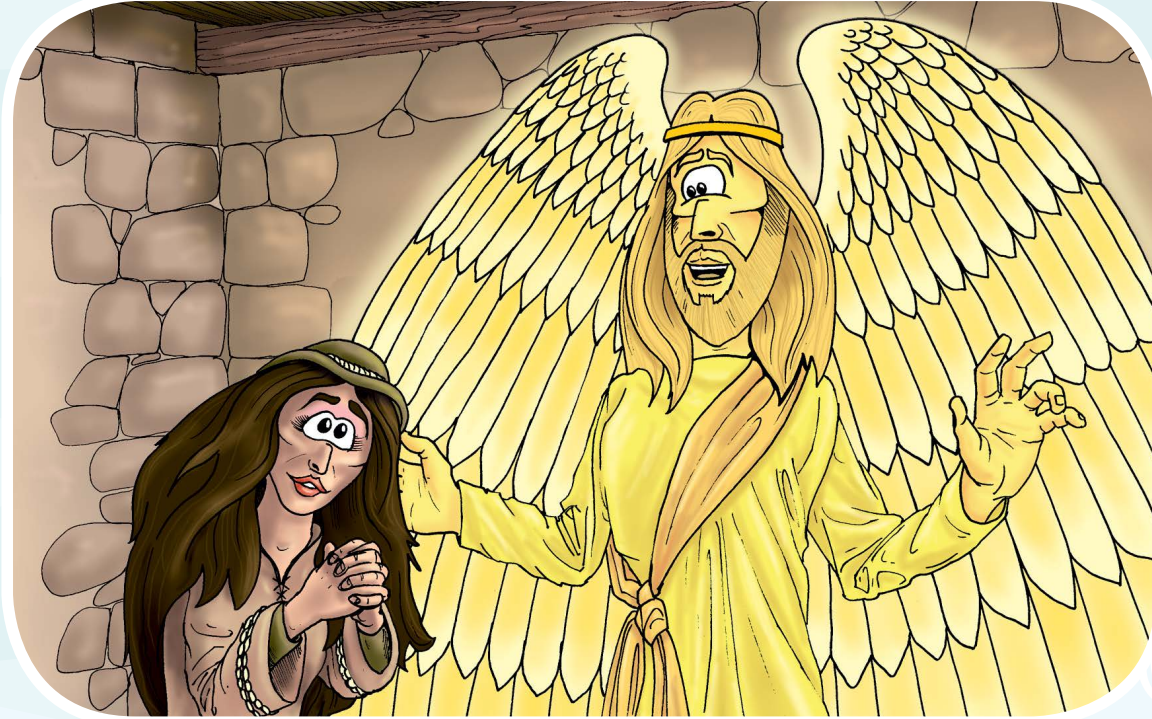
