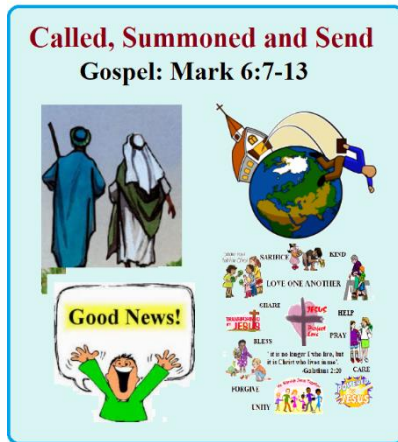


“Called, Summoned and Send”

Gospel: Mark 6:7-13

In the gospel today, we see Jesus summoning the twelve disciples for their mission. He sends them out in pairs giving them the authority over unclean spirits. Jesus instructed them,

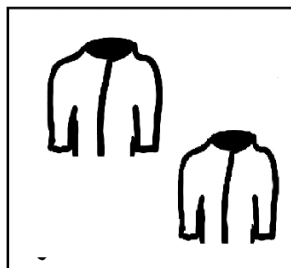
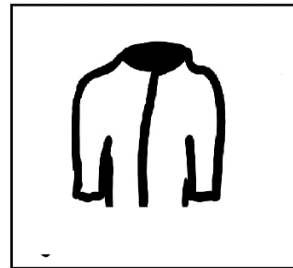
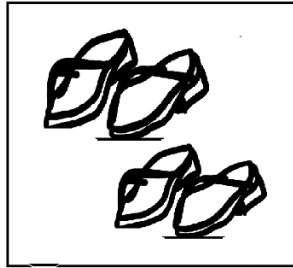
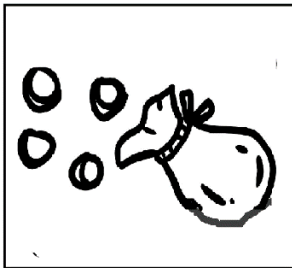
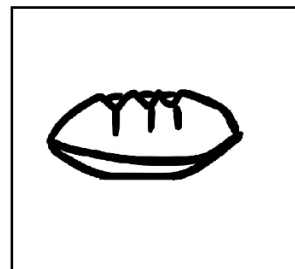
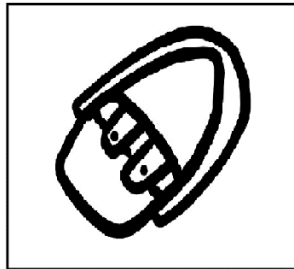
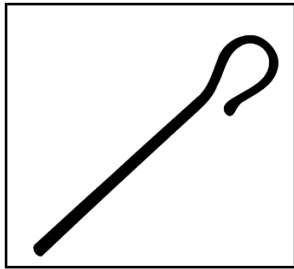
- take nothing for the journey except a staff

- no coppers for the purses.
- ‘do not take a spare tunic.’
- Wear sandals.

Jesus asked them to stay at the house they enter, until they leave the district. Jesus also asked them to shake off the dust from under their feet as they walk away from places that does not welcome them. This is a sign to the people who refuse to listen to them. So, the disciples set off to preach repentance. They casted out many devils and anointed many sick people with oil and cured them.

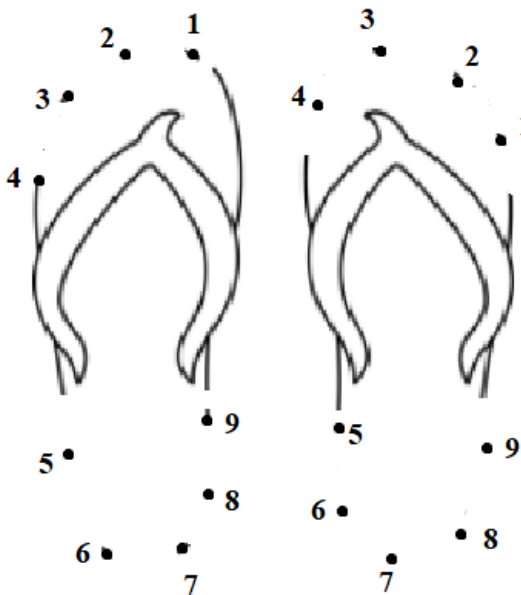

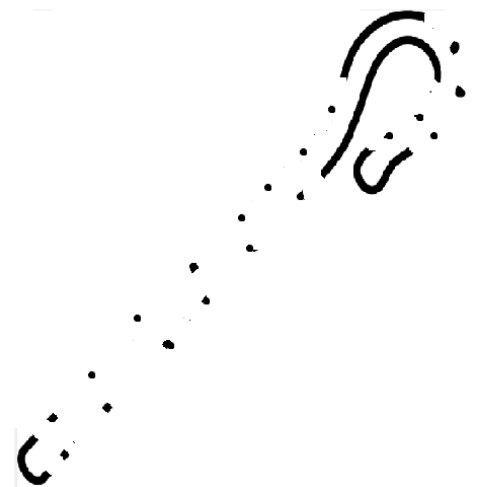

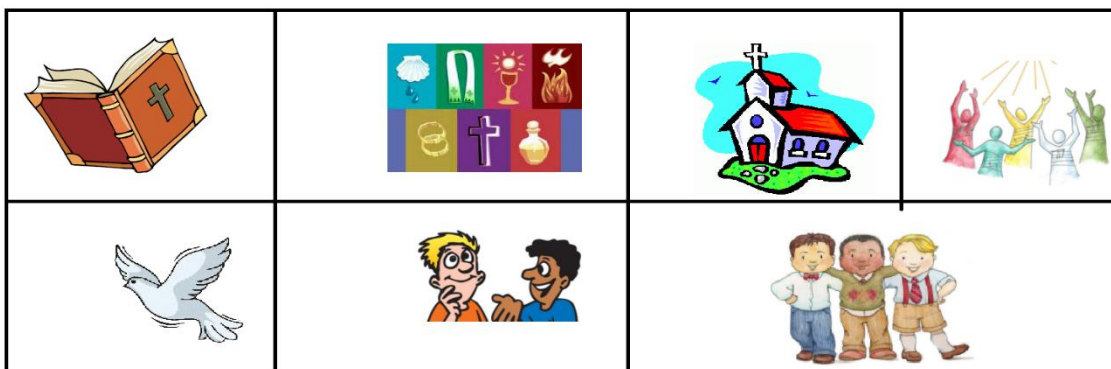
